### A Boy and His Dog (1975) [93 min.]

Directed by L.Q. Jones

Set in the not-too-distant future following the ravages of World War IV, this is a kinky, darkly comic cult classic based on the writings of iconic speculative fiction author Harlan Ellison. A young man (Don Johnson) and his talkative, telepathic dog toil in the post-nuke wasteland, scavenging for food and sex while battling ruthless raiders, androids & mutants. When the dynamic duo are lured to a strange underground city, our hero will have to learn that a dog might be his best, and only, friend.

### The Omega Man (1971) [98 min.]

Directed by Boris Sagal

In this tensely thrilling adaptation of Richard Matheson's classic sci-fi novel *I Am Legend*, Charlton Heston stars as an army doctor whose experimental vaccine has rendered him immune to the biological warfare that obliterated humanity. Between fighting off a horde of mutated, black-robed ghouls and their post-apocalyptic cult leader (Anthony Zerbe), he discovers an uninfected survivor (Rosalind Cash) and races against time to replicate his cure and save the future of mankind.

### The Girl From Starship Venus (1975) [81 min.]

In this softcore sci-fi satire, a Venusian spacecraft lands in London and its alien visitor transforms into a beautifully buxom human female, resulting in a swinging string of hilariously sexy encounters in porn shops, massage parlors and strip joints in a campy quest to investigate the inhabitants of our strange planet. German cheesecake model Monika Ringwald stars, drawing big laughs from deadpan comedy in a film that Quentin Tarantino calls one of the top twenty grindhouse classics!

### Barbarella (1968) [98 min.]

Wearing go-go boots, a space bikini and not much else, Jane Fonda is Barbarella, an astronaut from the 41st century tasked with travelling the galaxy in search of scientist Durand Durand - bouncing from one exotic planet, dangerous scenario and sexual situation to the next, encountering a blind angel (John Phillip Law), a resistance leader (David Hemmings), and more along the way.

### Flash Gordon: Rocket Ship (1936) [68 min.]

Directed by Frederick Stephani
