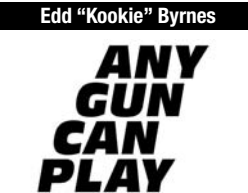

Directed by Richard Rush
In a time of increasing campus turmoil, a non-conformist former student activist returns to college, and an uncertain future, after a stint in Vietnam. Elliott Gould plays a man torn between two worlds, the aging academic establishment he's working to join and the social uprising embodied by his socially radical girlfriend (Candice Bergen). Richard Rush's shaggy-haired counterculture comedy captures the pulse of a changing generation.

Blast off with a candy-colored, sexily surreal camp classic from producer Dino De Laurentiis and director Roger Vadim! Wearing go-go boots, a space bikini and not much else, Jane Fonda is Barbarella, an astronaut from the 41st century travelling the galaxy in search of scientist Durand Durand, bouncing from one exotic planet, dangerous scenario and sexual situation to the next - encountering John Phillip Law, David Hemmings, and more along the way.

Peter Sellers explores hilarious new territory in a flower power psychedelic comedy written by Paul Mazursky and Larry Tucker. With the help of a batch of Alice B. Toklas' groovy hash brownies, Harold Fine (Sellers) goes from square lawyer to dedicated dropout, trading his "straight" life for bell bottoms and free love, while falling head over heels for his brother's hippie girlfriend (Leigh Taylor-Young).

Quentin Tarantino's *Once Upon a Time in...
