Cult filmmakers director William Lustig and screenwriter Larry Cohen team for a horrifically hilarious star spangled shocker perfect for these trying political times. When the body of a Desert Storm vet rises from the grave on the 4th of July, he unleashes a red-blooded rampage on the unpatriotic denizens of his All-American home town. Draft dodgers, tax cheats, crooked politicians and flag-burners beware: Uncle Sam wants you... DEAD!

Riveting performances from Naomi Watts and Laura Elena Harring anchor a narrative that nearly swallows itself whole, with a gorgeous score from Angelo Badalamenti.

Ray Harryhausen's breathtakingly unforgettable movie magic shines in one of cinema's most beloved fantasy adventures. You'll gasp at the towering gladiator statue Talos, thrill to the bat-winged Harpies that torment Phineas, stare with wonder at the fish-tailed Triton rising from the sea, and flinch at the many-headed Hydra, whose teeth give rise to another skeleton army in one of Harryhausen's most technically demanding and celebrated sequences.



November 23 & 24 at 2:00pm Mysterious Island (1961) [101 min.] Directed by Cy Endfield

A world beyond imagination and an adventure beyond belief! Mysterious Island cleverly augments Jules Verne's original story of shipwreck survival with a procession of gigantic creatures and prehistoric beasts. Cy Endfield's direction deftly balances the film's dramatics and special effects, combining classically trained actors and a stellar Bernard Herrmann score with maestro Ray Harryhausen's magnificent monsters to create spectacular results.
