Directed by Floyd Mutrux

Bobby has a '68 Camaro. Rose has a five-year-old kid. When a prank on their first date has tragic consequences, they become lovers and fugitives. Paul Le Mat and Dianne Hull portray two California kids trapped in dead-end lives but looking for a brighter future. Featuring a stacked soundtrack of classic tunes and incredible footage of '70s Los Angeles, writerdirector Floyd Mutrux presents a neglected gem that's ripe for rediscovery.

Mean Dog Blues (1978) [108 min.]

Directed by Mel Stuart

When a young country singer hitches a ride with a drunk driver who runs down a little girl, he takes the rap, gets double-crossed by a corrupt lawyer, and is sentenced to hard time on a brutal Southern chain gang. No one has ever escaped from Prison Camp #4 but this kid is going to try! In his big screen debut, Gregg Henry plays the convict on the run, while George Kennedy plays the snarling, sadistic foreman hot on his trail.



Saturday • February 22 Carmen, Baby (1967) [90 min.]

Directed by Radley Metzger

Visionary arthouse erotica auteur Radley Metzger's sizzling update of the opera Carmen is a gorgeously lavish tale about a sexy temptress whose scintillating spell seductively lures a naive small-town cop to desire and downfall. Featuring stylish photography, cool European locales and late '60s fashion, plus a stunning Uta Levka in the lead role.



Saturday • February 29 **The Hospital** (1971) [103 min.]

Directed by Arthur Hiller

Screenwriter Paddy Chayefsky's Academy Award-winning satire is a pitch-black dark comedy about madness, murder, and malpractice in a Manhattan teaching hospital. An Oscar-nominated George C. Scott stars as a bitter, suicidal doctor struggling to stay afloat amidst the chaos in his life, both personal and professional, while a series of sudden deaths plagues his inept medical institution.

February 1 & 2 at 2:00pm **Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone**

Directed by Chris Columbus (2001) [152 min.]

Enter a world of enchantment and mystery with the first film in the blockbuster book-to-screen franchise. The humdrum life of a young orphan is transformed on his eleventh birthday when he discovers magic is real and that his parents were powerful wizards. Whisked away to the Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry, he'll make new friends while harnessing his newfound powers and discovering dark secrets about his past.



Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets

Directed by Chris Columbus (2002) [161 min.]

As Harry, Hermione, and Ron enter their second year at Hogwarts, they soon discover something strangely amiss. Students are turning into stone and writing on the walls exclaims "The Chambers of Secrets has been opened." The trio will have to summon all their courage and use their ever-growing magical abilities to solve the mystery and save the school in this exhilarating follow-up.

February 15 & 16 at 2:00pm **Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban** Directed by Alfonso Cuarón (2004) [142 min.]

Award-winning director Alfonso Cuarón helms the spectacularly spellbinding third adventure in the Potter saga, as Harry and his trusted companions encounter new dangers when a fearsome wizard escapes the famed Azkaban prison. While trying to master his magical studies, Harry must put together the puzzle of the mysterious prisoner's past.

February 22 & 23 at 2:00pm **Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire**

Directed by Mike Newell (2005) [157 min.]

The fourth film in the franchise finds everything about to change for Harry and his Hogwarts pals as they leave childhood behind and find themselves faced with dangers beyond imagination, not to mention the terrors of finding a dance partner for the Yule Ball. Our hero will have to balance schoolwork, friendship, and the TriWizard Tournament when he's mysteriously drawn into a hazardous competition between rival schools.

February 29 & March 1 at 2:00pm **Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix**

Directed by David Yates (2007) [138 min.]

The rebellion begins! Following Harry's deadly battle with the dark lord, the Ministry of Magic is curiously covering up the truth of Voldemort's return. Harry, Ron, and Hermione will have to band together to secretly train a small group of their Hogwarts classmates in preparation for the wizarding war ahead in this exciting and fast-paced fifth entry.
