




Saturday • April 1

**Slaughter High (1986)** [90 min.]

Directed by George Dugdale, Mark Ezra & Peter Litten

Take a trip through the Halls of Horror! In a viciously deranged, outrageously demented slasher sickie from the producers of *Pieces*, an April Fool's prank goes horribly wrong. 


April 22 & 23 at 2:00pm


