Directed by Eli Roth

At a remote cabin deep in the woods, a group of college friends find themselves in a fight for their lives against a gruesome, flesh-eating virus. But as they try to dodge fatal contagion from each other, they'll also have to contend with a collection of homicidal locals. Eli Roth's blood-drenched directorial debut delivers a gory good time packed with gallows humor and grisly KNB effects.

In the third chapter of the blockbuster sensation, a swooning tale of teenage love, immortality, & lycanthropy, Bella (Kristen Stewart) is confronted with the most important decision of her life: Edward (Robert Pattinson) or Jacob (Taylor Lautner). And with high school graduation quickly approaching, and a string of mysterious murders plaguing the Northwest, it's a choice that could dangerously reignite a centuries-old supernatural conflict.

The Fly (1986) [96 min.]

Directed by David Cronenberg

A big screen love story unlike anything you've ever seen, David Cronenberg's '80s update of *The Fly* is as terrifyingly tragic as its ultra-gooey Oscar-winning special effects are jaw-droppingly grotesque. When an eccentric scientist (Jeff Goldblum) uses himself as a test subject, he soon discovers himself devolving into something not quite human, with disastrous consequences to the relationship with his reporter girlfriend (Geena Davis). Bringing his body horror fascination to the mainstream, Cronenberg crafts a gross-out masterpiece that targets the heart as well as the stomach.

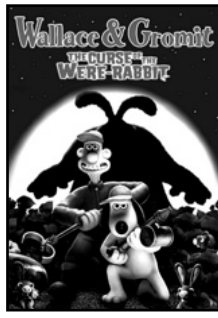
