I Come in Peace (1990) [92 min.]

Directed by Craig R. Baxley

Houston cop Jack Caine thought he'd busted every breed of crook on Earth... but what he's up against this Christmas isn't human. Tasked with taking down the local drug trade, the rogue detective is saddled with a by-the-books FBI agent, and soon their paths will cross with an extraterrestrial visitor looking for a brand new high. Dolph Lundgren stars in a badass blast of sci-fi action from stuntman-turned-director Craig R. Baxley.
