Director Nicolas Winding Refn unleashes an uncompromising maelstrom of mud, blood, madness and Mads Mikkelsen in a hypnotic exploration of faith and extreme violence.

The rich have always fed off the poor. This time it's for real. A teenager's alienation from his Beverly Hills family leads to a shocking discovery. Director Brian Yuzna and special effects wizard Screaming Mad George team for an icky, sticky, totally gonzo body horror social satire with a climax so surreally jaw-dropping, you'll never be the same again.

Tank Girl (1995) [104 min.]

Directed by Rachel Talalay

In the future, the odds of survival are 1000 to 1. That's just the way she likes it. When the evil Water & Power corporation and its tyrannical leader squash dissent across the drought-ravaged wasteland, a defiant Tank Girl and her band of rebels will have to fight back. Lori Petty headlines a big screen update of the cult comic book from director Rachel Talalay and production designer Catherine Hardwicke.

Fight Club (1999) [139 min.]

Directed by David Fincher

The first rule of Fight Club is: You do not talk about Fight Club. David Fincher's stylized adaptation of the Chuck Palahniuk book is a darkly humorous and intoxicatingly energetic film thunderbolt, a visually striking, critically polarizing, and often misunderstood examination of modern-day man, mischief, madness, mayhem and soap. Brad Pitt, Edward Norton, and Helena Bonham Carter turn in powerful performances, while the Dust Brothers provide a propulsive score.

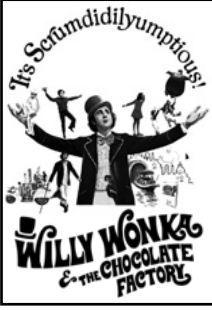
