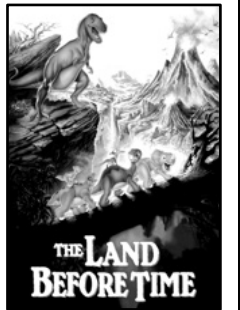

There he catches the eye of the governor's daughter (Olivia de Havilland), leads an escape, and achieves fame & fortune as the notorious Captain Blood. Nominated for 5 Academy Awards, including Best Picture and Best Director.
