**Directed by Toyoo Ashida**

The concert was "the best live performance of the year." The movie is Big Time. Legendary singer Tom Waits brings his singular sense of humor to craft a music film like no other, a highly theatrical arthouse fever dream of songs and sketches. Filmed at the Warfield Theater in San Francisco and the Wiltern Theater in Los Angeles, Big Time captures Waits and his magnetic charisma at his peak.

## Army of Darkness (1992) [81 min.]

**Directed by Sam Raimi**

Bruce Campbell returns as Ash in Sam Raimi's gonzo third film in his *Evil Dead* franchise, a madcap mashup of action & adventure, quotable dialogue, Three Stooges-style slapstick, Ray Harryhausen-esque effects, and 100% FUN. Trapped in the Middle Ages, Ash will have to fight through an army of the undead in a quest to return home.
