

Saturday • March 1 A Scanner Darkly (2006) [100 min.]

Directed by Richard Linklater

Everything is not going to be ok. In the not-to-distant future, a hallucinogenic drug has swept the nation and the government uses a high-tech surveillance system to monitor its populace. When an undercover officer becomes addicted to Substance D, he'll begin to lose his own identity. Writer-Director Richard Linklater adapts Philip K. Dick's novel, crafting a surreal & kaleidoscopic sci-fi mind-bender through rotoscope animation.



Saturday • March 8 Lady Vengeance (2005) [115 min.]

Directed by Park Chan-wook

All she wanted was a peaceful life... they didn't give it. Wrongfully convicted & imprisoned, a woman earns an early release for her model behavior and spiritual transformation. Now free, she can enact her violent and long-planned retribution. Lee Young-ae & Choi Min-sik star in *Oldboy* director Park Chan-wook's expert thriller.



Saturday • March 15 Clueless (1995) [97 min.]

Directed by Amy Heckerling

Loosely based on Jane Austen's *Emma, Clueless* updates the setting to modern day Beverly Hills, following the posh & popular Cher (a brilliant Alicia Silverstone) and her clique of friends. But when she gives an unhip classmate a new makeover, it could prove problematic for her place in the pecking order at school. Filled with iconic fashion, clever dialogue, and a killer supporting cast, *Clueless* stands as one of the best comedies of its generation.

Directed by David Cronenberg

Buckle up, David Cronenberg's audacious adaptation of J. G. Ballard's "unfilmable" novel pushes into bold new territory. The director's trademark obsession of body and flesh collides with cold steel and hot asphalt when a man survives a brutal wreck and becomes dangerously drawn into a mysterious subculture that explores the link between erotic fulfillment and vehicular violence. James Spader, Holly Hunter, Elias Koteas, Deborah Kara Unger, and Rosanna Arquette fill out a stellar ensemble cast.



Saturday • March 29 Ginger Snaps 2: Unleashed (2004) [94 min.]

Directed by Brett Sullivan

It only dies if you do. Haunted by the memories of her sister Ginger, Brigitte (Emily Perkins) must find a lycanthropic cure before her own transformation. But there's another werewolf circling, and he's got her scent in his sights. When an overdose of wolfsbane sends her to a rehabilitation clinic for teen addicts, she'll befriend a strange young girl (Tatiana Maslany in her feature film debut) who promises to help.

Tobey Maguire returns to the webbed suit, battling both inner demons and the dangerous Dr. Octopus, while balancing heroic obligations, his feelings for Mary Jane, and the need to repair his relationship with former best friend Harry Osborn.
