

**Directed by Roger Donaldson** 

Michael Madsen Tribute

For three million years, the human race has been at the top of the evolutionary ladder. Nothing lasts forever. And when scientists receive an interstellar transmission with alien instructions, they create a deadly new humanoid organism. Men cannot resist her. Mankind may not survive her. Natasha Henstridge and Michael Madsen star in a slick blast of sci-fi horror from director Roger Donaldson (Cocktail, No Way Out).

A student radical on the run from the law encounters a woman on their way to the desert in Italian auteur Michelangelo Antonioni's sole American feature, a bold, meditative, and visually striking counterculture head trip, backed by a soundtrack featuring Pink Floyd, Grateful Dead, and more.

The future is history. When a prisoner is sent back in time to investigate a deadly plague, he's launched too far and hospitalized at a mental institution, where he encounters a fellow patient who may be the key to his mission. Bruce Willis, Brad Pitt, and Madeleine Stowe star, while director Terry Gilliam (Brazil, Time Bandits) meticulously crafts an unforgettable sci-fi mind-shocker that rewards multiple viewings.



### **Saturday • August 23 Fast Times at Ridgemont High** (1982) [90 min.]

**Directed by Amy Heckerling** 

Carefully capturing the details of teenage life in a fresh & funny way that would help define the decade, Fast Times at Ridgemont High may well be the pinnacle of '80s high school age hilarity. Director Amy Heckerling & screenwriter Cameron Crowe nail the real-life emotions, vocabulary, and attitude of its adolescent protagonists, while Phoebe Cates, Sean Penn, and Jennifer Jason Leigh were catapulted to stardom on screen.
