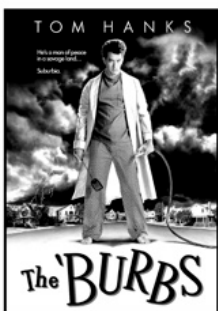
Saturday • July 4 I Know What You Did Last Summer

Directed by Jim Gillespie (1997) [101 min.]
If you're going to bury the truth, make sure it stays buried. When four high school friends celebrating the 4th of July make a deadly mistake, it will come back to haunt them. Featuring a peak-of-the-era teen cast including Jennifer Love Hewitt, Sarah Michelle Gellar, Ryan Phillippe, and Freddie Prinze Jr., screenwriter Kevin Williamson's follow-up to his blockbuster hit *Scream* cemented the slasher revival of the late '90s.



Saturday • July 11 Punch-Drunk Love (2002) [95 min.]

Directed by Paul Thomas Anderson
Paul Thomas Anderson's strangely funny and emotionally complex exploration of loneliness, love, and human connection provides comedian Adam Sandler with the role he was born to play. Sandler stars as a shy, love-starved man whose uneventful life is sent spinning topsy-turvy when he meets a woman (Emily Watson) who works with his sister. The unconventional, unpredictable plot adds phone sex extortion, frequent flier miles, and lots and lots of pudding.



Saturday • July 18 The 'Burbs (1989) [102 min.]

Directed by Joe Dante
Living in the suburbs can feel like a nightmare. And in director Joe Dante's *The 'Burbs*, the nightmare is real when the neighbors in a quiet cul-de-sac begin to think that the creepy new family that just moved in might actually be a bunch of killers. It's a quirky & paranoid cult comedy led by a stacked cast featuring Tom Hanks, Bruce Dern, Carrie Fisher, Rick Ducommun, and Corey Feldman.



Saturday • July 25 Dazed and Confused (1993) [102 min.]

Directed by Richard Linklater
The breakthrough hit for director Richard Linklater, *Dazed and Confused* is perhaps the greatest hangout movie of all time. A coming-of-age ensemble comedy set on the last day of school 1976, the film manages to define the timeless experience of high school itself. Featuring early roles for Matthew McConaughey, Ben Affleck, and Parker Posey, this stoner timepiece remains totally irresistible and a fitting tribute to the worst / greatest years of your life.

Directed by Robert Stevenson

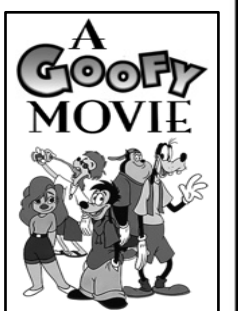
