Written & Directed by Quentin Tarantino

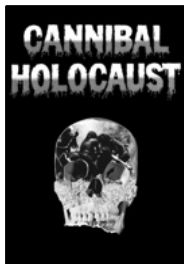


Saturday • August 1

Dredd (2012) [96 min.]

Directed by Pete Travis

In a hyper-violent dystopic metropolis, an elite law enforcement group acts as judge, jury, and executioner. And when veteran officer Judge Dredd (Karl Urban) and his young recruit (Olivia Thirlby) arrive at a 200-storey tower block to investigate a murder, they'll find themselves in a ruthless battle with a vicious drug kingpin (Lena Headey) and her seemingly endless army of killers. Screenwriter Alex Garland adapts the legendary comic.



Saturday • August 8

Cannibal Holocaust (1980) [96 min.]

Directed by Ruggero Deodato

An anthropologist ventures to South America in search of a group who went missing while filming a documentary about cannibal tribes. And when he finds their lost footage, it will contain the shocking truth about their gruesome fate. The most controversial movie ever made has lost none of its unflinching power, a cruel cinematic landmark featuring special effects so realistic that the director was arrested on suspicion of murder.

Nirvana the Band the Show the Movie (2025) [100 min.]

Directed by Matt Johnson

The cult Canadian show makes the giant leap to the big screen with this wildly ambitious & riotously funny instant-classic that demands to be seen with an audience. When their elaborate plans to book a show at the Rivoli goes horribly wrong, a pair of best buds (Matt Johnson & Jay McCarroll) accidentally get sent back in time to the year 2008.

Ghost World (2001) [111 min.]

Directed by Terry Zwigoff

Documentary filmmaker Terry Zwigoff's first fictional feature is a biting funny adaptation of Daniel Clowes' famed underground comic. A sardonic Thora Birch and a young Scarlett Johansson are quintessential teenage outsiders adrift in post-high school ennui. But crossing paths with kindred spirit Seymour (Steve Buscemi) will change their friendship forever. Filled with a dream team supporting cast, *Ghost World* creates specific, believable people and all-too-relatable cringe-inducing laughs.

Directed by Dave Thomas and Rick Moranis

Canadian slackers Bob & Doug McKenzie (Rick Moranis & Dave Thomas) will do anything to keep the suds flowing. 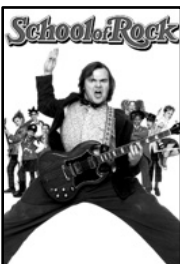

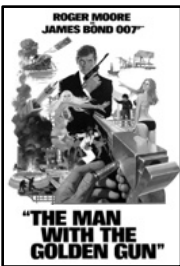
