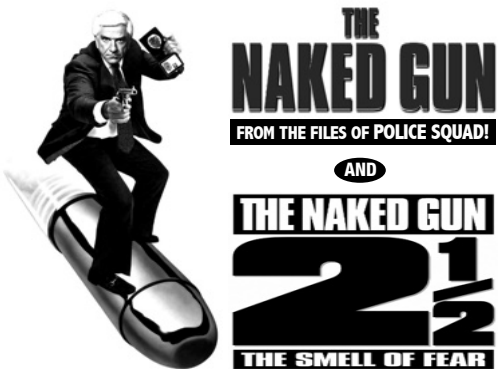
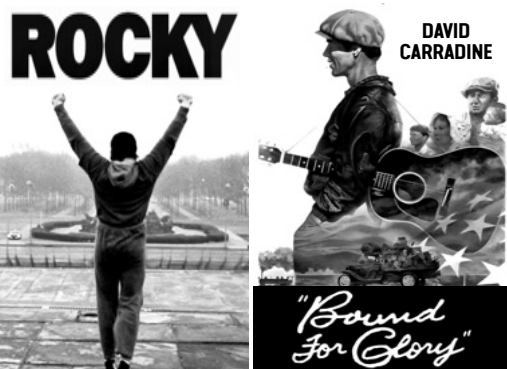

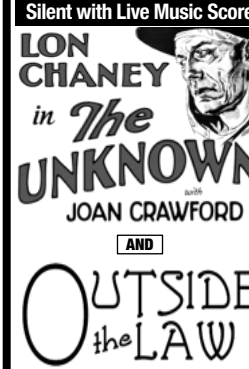

Directed by John Carpenter

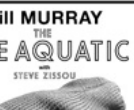

Directed by Ralph Bakshi

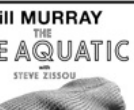
