

Saturday • December 1 Dazed and Confused (1993) [102 min.]

Written and Directed by Richard Linklater

Perhaps the greatest hang out movie of all time, Dazed & Confused was a breakthrough hit for director Richard Linklater after the indie success of Slacker. This coming-of-age ensemble comedy set on the last day of school 1976 is a retrofit nostalgia trip, defining not just that bicentennial summer, but the timeless experience of high school itself. Featuring early roles for Ben Affleck, Parker Posey, Adam Goldberg and Joey Lauren Adams, this stoner timepiece remains essential viewing.

Twice the terror! Scream with a nightmarish holiday horror favorite plus a frighteningly festive, top secret bonus feature for a stocking stuffer treat!



Celebrate a "Gotham Christmas" as Tim Burton's massively entertaining follow-up to his groundbreaking Batman blockbuster goes bigger and bolder with the Penguin (Danny DeVito), Catwoman (Michelle Peiffer), and corrupt businessman Max Shreck (Christopher Walken) out to rid the world of the caped crusader (Michael Keaton). Batman Returns remains one of filmdom's most ambitious sequels, showcasing incredible production design and visual effects along with standout performances.

When Jack Skellington, the Pumpkin King of Malloween, stumbles across the festive delights of Christmas, he decides he must escape his same spooky routine and make the Yuletide his own. But his merry mischief causes more mayhem than magic, proving our skeletal star still has much to learn about the true meaning of the holiday. Director Henry Selick crams exquisite detail into every inch of the frame while Danny Elfman provides the tunes.



December 15 & 16 at 2:00pm The Muppet Christmas Carol (1992) [86 min.] **Directed by Brian Henson**

Revisit the timeless Dickens tale of compassion and charity with your prized puppet pals in *The Muppet Christmas Carol*l Ebenezer Scrooge (Michael Caine) is the greediest, grumpiest git in all of London until he's taken on a mystical journey of self-discovery by the three Ghosts of Christmas Past, Present and Yet to Come. You should know the rules by now: Don't expose them to bright light. Don't get them wet. And above all, don't feed them after midnight. So join Gizmo and all the other furry, monstrous Gremlins as they burst off the screen in the greatest small-town onliday adventure since It's A Wonderful Life! This bonanza of proliferating pests is a hristmas-comedy-horror classic resulting from the collaboration between director Joe Dante, writer Chris Columbus, and Steven Spielberg's Amblin Entertainment.
